It's time for Rishi Sunak to fire up the engine of the East Midlands!

Along with colleagues, I've written to the Secretary of State for Levelling Up to press the case for the East Midlands to be given even more clout and funding.

Our new devolution deal will bring money and powers to our area, and is a big step forward, offering us opportunities in transport, skills and investment.

At the same time though, Andy Burnham in Manchester, already equipped with more powers than we are, is taking further steps in new 'Trailblazer' deals announced in the Budget.

My colleagues and I argue that the East Midlands should be at the front of the queue to 'level up' and that Government can't allow Manchester and Birmingham to disappear in to the distance.

As a Conservative, I also want to see "Levelling up" defined by conservative principles; innovation, enterprise, and offering more opportunity, not by the left-wing versions in Manchester and London, with congestion charges and anti-car policies that limit choice and make lives harder.

We've asked the Secretary of State to consider this, and to equip our area with new opportunities that Manchester has had for 5+ years already, like new local trade and investment policy, on top of the exciting new deal we've already secured.




Warsop residents meeting




Funding boost for road safety across England
